**VOTER REGISTRATION DEADLINE: FEBRUARY 18TH, 2020**

Florida is a Closed Primary State. This means that only registered Democrats may vote for Democratic candidates and only registered Republicans may vote for Republican candidates. Registered voters with no party affiliation or with minor party affiliation are not eligible to vote in this election

Polk County residents who are not registered to vote, but would like to participate in the March 17th PPP Election, have until February 18th to submit their completed voter registration form to the Elections Headquarters in Bartow or at our Operations Center in Winter Haven.
